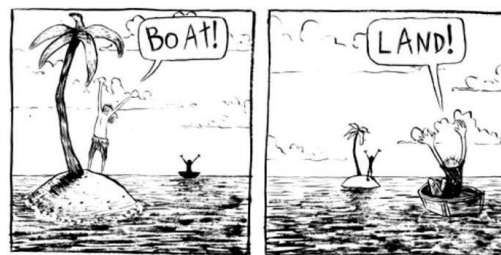


Welcome!

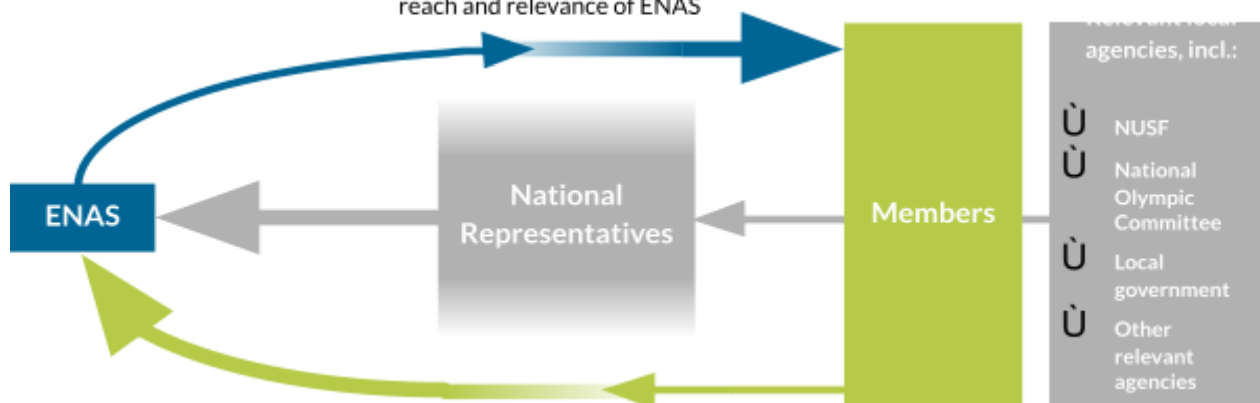

Candidature & Selection

National Representatives | The list of National Representatives (NR), incl. one contact per country, is renewed every year at the annual Forum & Assembly as part of a National Representatives Meeting usually planned on the Forum arrival day (Tuesday). For reasons of continuity, we prefer National Representatives to stay on for at least 2 years. When a National Representative wants to be replaced, he/she should direct us to a colleague who will take over the responsibilities for the next year(s).

Chairperson | At the National Representatives Meeting, the NR's select a chairperson who holds a one year mandate. The chairperson acts as a close contact between EC, ENAS Office and National Representatives to ensure consultation with the National Representatives is coordinated, timely and frequent.

General Assembly Confirmation | The election of the chairperson and the full list of National Representatives are confirmed by the General Assembly.
