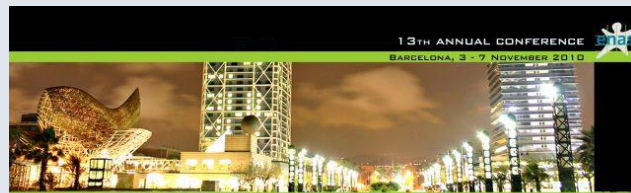
We will have the opportunity to discuss how to integrate sport, health and wellbeing into our University mission.

You will only need the following data to transfer money to ENAS:

There are no other data required to transfer money. If you still have to pay old invoices of ENAS - just use the old bank account of ENAS that's on the invoice. It can still be used for a few months.

All members will receive the invoices for the membership fee 2011 in March. The invoices will only be sent in a digital form and they have to be paid by bank transfer. Cheques will no longer be accepted.

39th BATAVIERENRACE



The Batavierenrace is an annual student relay race starting in Nijmegen and finishing in Enschede. The route is divided into 25 stages, of which 17 are men's and 8 are women's stages. The length of these stages varies from 3.3 to 11.2 km, with the entire route of the Batavierenrace covering over 177 km.

In total, 330 teams can participate in the Batavierenrace. With 25 participants per team, the number of participants is almost 8,000 per year.

With this number of participants, the Batavierenrace is mentioned in the Guinness Book of Records with 'most participants in a relay race!' The race starts on the 7th of May 2011 at midnight at Nijmegen. Almost 18 hours later, the finish will be in Enschede at the campus of the University of Twente. After the race there is the possibility to celebrate your personal victory at Europe's biggest student party; the Batavierenparty!
