ENAS is entitled to get a small percentage of the total amount that Life Fitness charged our members.

## ENAS Membership

At the end of May the membership invoices for the year 2011 were sent to all our members. The membership fee should be paid before July 1.

The EC decided at its meeting in London to suspend the Tomas Bata University (Czech Republic), the Sporthochschule Köln (Germany), Technion Haifa (Israel), the University of Bacau (Romania) and the University of Ljubljana (Slovenia) because of outstanding debts to ENAS.

From now on ENAS will be very strict: members who don't pay their membership fee, can't take part in the ENAS conference. This rule shouldn't be confused with the rule that non members have to pay an extra fee of € 251,- for every representative they send to the conference. If a suspended university wants to join ENAS again and/or wants to participate in the yearly conference, it should first pay its outstanding debts.

## ENAS Elections

All members interested to apply for a position in the EC must follow our constitution:

The candidates for the President, Treasurer and Secretary-General shall be nominated in advance by the delegates attending the General Assembly.

Under penalty of inadmissibility, the nominations must be written in English and deposited with the Secretary-General of ENAS thirty days prior to the date of the General Assembly.
