1. European Year of Education through Sports (EYES 2004)

Unfortunately ENAS was not chosen for grant in EYES subsidies. By mid July, more than 2 months after we should have received the official answer, ENAS was informed of not being among the selected projects. The arguments therefore are very general. The EC is not happy with the procedure and the decision. The President will contact the head of European Sport Unit. The EC members will discuss the decision and the procedure with their EU representatives.

2. Sponsorship and new partner

EC member Asbjørn Amundsen and the President had a final discussion with Technogym, who sell fitness machine equipment, in Bologna. The EC is convinced about the quality of the company's products and the benefit of a partnership for ENAS. A contract will be signed very soon, giving the company various communication options, while ENAS receives sponsorship for conference, a general sponsorship and a best price offer for equipment. A detailed report will be presented at ENAS' General Assembly in Oslo.
