Trondheim has its own international airport, Værnes (TRD), which operates direct flights to/from a number of international locations, including: Alicante, Amsterdam, Barcelona, Dubrovnik, Gdansk, Gran Canaria, Krakow, Copenhagen, London Gatwick, Malaga, Murcia, Nice, Pula, Reykjavik, Riga, Split, Stockholm and Tallinn. We kindly advise you to book early as prices may heavily differ and possible travel routes may be limited.

POWER	220-240V Make sure to bring a power adapter to Adapter for "Type C" and/or "Type E/F" most commonly used anywhere on mainland Europe.
WEATHER	Trondheim has a subarctic climate with strong winters. Average temperatures in November vary between -2°C and 4°C. There might even be snow ❄️
DAYLIGHT	We are travelling to the land of the midnight sun in wintertime which means there are only a limited number of daylight hours. Sunrise is expected around 8:30, sunset at 15:30 during the conference time.
ALCOHOL	Very strict rules apply. Drinking in public places is illegal. High tax levels result in high prices for alcoholic drinks and strict import policies exist, see here .

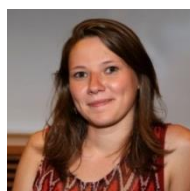
